## VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

In the fall of 2010, Atlantic Golf Club will have the honor of hosting the 30<sup>th</sup> Mid-Amateur Championship. Along with the US Open and the US Amateur this is one of the USGA's most prestigious events drawing players from across the country to claim the title of best amateur golfer.

The Championship will be held over the course of six days plus two days of practice rounds beginning on Wednesday, September 22, 2010. The staff and membership of Atlantic are committed to making 2010 the finest Mid-Amateur Championship ever held. This is an enormous undertaking and with that in mind we reach out to you, the members of our community, for your assistance. We are looking to recruit approximately 300 volunteers to serve in areas both on and off the course. There are a variety of volunteer options to suit almost anyone's interests and availability. Complete descriptions of volunteer positions are on the following page.

Anyone who participates will find this a fun and rewarding experience as well as a unique opportunity to be part of this prestigious event. Volunteers who commit to a minimum of three (3) shifts will receive:

- ◆ An official Mid-Am uniform consisting of a golf shirt, hat and wind shirt.
- ◆ Meals provided during shifts.
- ◆ A "thank-you" golf outing for volunteers will be held at Atlantic and/or The Bridge sometime after the Championship.

Volunteers also agree to attend training sessions at dates and times to be determined.

**NOTE: As we expect to have more volunteers than needed, preference will be given to those who are able to commit to (4) or more shifts.**

## **Volunteer Committees for the 2010 Mid-Am Championship:**

### **OFF COURSE:**

#### **Concierge**

Staff hospitality desk at Atlantic Golf Club providing local information to our guests in regards to activities, directions and other special requests; also print and distribute starting time sheets for each day. (Wed. 9/22 to Mon. 9/27)

#### **Golf Course Supplies**

Distribute water, sport beverages and ice to on-course coolers; empty trash receptacles throughout the facility. Volunteers may be required to lift heavy objects. Must be at least 25 years of age, and have a valid driver's license. Morning shifts may begin as early as 5:30 a.m. (Wed. 9/22 to Thurs. 9/30)

#### **Medical/First Aid**

Per USGA requirements must be a doctor, emergency medical technician, and/or registered nurse. (Wed. 9/22 to Thurs. 9/30)

#### **Parking**

Assist in the efficient use of all parking facilities on and off the property; access control and general safety concerns at various restricted areas on site. Work with contracted security and parking company and local law enforcement to direct players, officials, staff and volunteers to designated areas. (Wed. 9/22 to Tues. 9/28)

#### **Player Registration**

Assist club staff with receiving player information and registering players. Volunteers may be asked to assist with organizing Player Information Packets prior to the official opening of Registration. (Tue. 9/21 to Fri. 9/24)

#### **Security**

Work with club staff to verify credentials and direct players, volunteers and guests to appropriate areas. Law enforcement or security background is preferred. (Wed. 9/22 to Wed. 9/29)

#### **Transportation**

Staff Transportation Desk coordinating shuttle, valet, taxi, and parking information for players and their guests. Oversee shuttles to 10<sup>th</sup> hole, parking facility, and between courses. Coordinate communication between drivers, hotel staff, host clubs and players. (Wed. 9/22 to Tues. 9/28)

#### **Volunteer Headquarters**

Check in volunteers for the various areas, answering questions, ensuring that the volunteer effort runs smoothly and every volunteer is in the right place at the right time. Shifts may begin as early as 5:30 a.m. (Wed. 9/22 to Thurs. 9/30)

## **ON-COURSE:**

### **Dispatch Rover**

Dispatch volunteers to proper drop off locations on each course; relieve on-course volunteers for short breaks. Must be at least 25 years of age and have a valid driver's license. Morning shifts for this position may begin as early as 5:30 a.m. (Wed. 9/22 to Mon. 9/27)

### **Marshals/Forecaddies**

Stationed at landing zones to assist in spotting errant balls; also manage spectators on the course ensuring that appropriate golf etiquette is observed. May also be asked to assist as evacuation drivers. Marshals/Forecaddies must be physically fit and able to walk 18 holes if necessary. Morning shifts for Marshals/Forecaddies may begin as early as 5:30 a.m. (Wed. 9/22 – Thurs. 9/30)

### **Scoring: Scoreboard**

Assist official scorekeeper with hanging name strips on scoreboard; receive and distribute scores, via electronic scoring devices and scorecards, to the official scorekeeper for posting. (Sat. 9/25 – Wed. 9/29)

### **Scoring: Scorecard Runners**

Deliver scorecards from 9<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> scoring areas to the championship scoreboard at Atlantic and the Real Time Scoring Center at The Bridge; deliver scorecards to Atlantic from The Bridge. (Sat. 9/25 – Sun. 9/26)

### **Scoring: Standard Bearers**

Responsible for carrying a two-sided scoring standard sign and for posting the status of the match on the standard. Must be physically fit and able to walk 18 holes. (Tues. 9/28 – Thurs. 9/30)

### **Scoring: Walking Scorers**

Walk with matches and enter scores, upon completion of each hole, into hand-held electronic scoring device. Must be physically fit and able to walk 18 holes. (Sat. 9/26 – Thurs. 9/30)
